

Online Discussions

Online discussions and consultations will be facilitated and moderated by the NEPAD Agency Technical Experts on ATVET, with external and internal co-moderators who have best practices to share on specific topics. The topics to be discussed can be raised by CoP members or by the ATVET CoP technical team.

The discussion forums will run for 2 weeks. The topic will be posted and thereafter the discussion will begin with contributions from CoP members, who are expected to fill the CoP with life. CoP members are encouraged to participate by sharing experiences, recommendations, best practices and lessons learnt on how they have initiated ATVET-related processes in their countries.

Contributions can be made in the form of comments, questions seeking clarification and sharing interesting articles in relation to the topic under discussion.

After the two week period of discussion, the topic will be closed and a summary of the discussion will be posted as an outcome document on the CoP document and resources section.

Workshops & Writeshops

The CAADP ATVET project seeks to facilitate a participatory and stakeholder-driven process of developing policy documents and engaging in discussions.

The project aims to hold one continental workshop per year, where participants are invited to attend and discuss on pertinent topics arising from the online discussion. These workshops will also include innovative concepts such as writeshops, where attending Cop members will get training and skills on developing relevant tools to support and improve implementation of ATVET in their countries.

Participation to attend the physical meetings will be sponsored by the CAADP ATVET project. Attendance is limited to those stakeholders to whom the topic is relevant and would be of direct benefit to.

Webinars

The webinar feature will allow real-time presentation and interactive sessions for all members. The purpose of the webinar is to complement the online discussions and, where presentations are available, to add substance and clarity on a topic a webinar will be scheduled for such purposes. The webinars will be recorded and made available for members who were unable to connect to the live session online.

Online Surveys

Surveys will be carried out from time to time to gather information on topics from stakeholders, for specific projects, studies, programmes on ongoing policy processes. The surveys will contain minimal personal information and every attempt to ensure and maintain the confidentiality of the survey participants will be taken.
